FS1

We will continue to perfect our performances of the nursery rhymes, ready to show parents/carers on 25th and 28th November. As it is Anti-Bullying week, in Circle Time, we will talk about how we can be a good friend in nursery and show kindness to others. We look forward to seeing parents/carers for the 'play and chat sessions' at 2pm daily next week.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue to build on the skills of matching numbers and objects, counting using our fingers and comparing groups of objects using the words 'more, less and the same'. We will be spotting shapes and numerals in the environment around school.

Phonics

This week we will be looking at sound discrimination using instruments and talking about how we can change the sounds they make. We will be listening and remembering sounds, copying different rhythms and talking about how we can use the instruments to accompany a story.

FS2

Next week is Anti-Bullying week. In FS2 we will be exploring what bullying is but also looking at similarities and differences between us and our friends and thinking about feelings.

Topic

Our book of the week will be Freddie and the Fairy. We will link this to similarities and differences and feelings.

Maths

In maths we will be counting and placing a number of objects with the correct numeral. As an extension of this we will be using money and matching coins to correct numerals. We will also be talking about money and what it is used for.

Phonics

In Phonics we will be finishing starting Phase 3. We will be learning the letter sounds j, w, v and x.
