



Dear Parents/carers,

This week we have begun our new writing topic, looking at a setting description from the Magician's Nephew. We have learnt a passage off by heart using actions to help us. Look out for this appearing on Class Dojo soon, and feel free to ask the children to demonstrate some of the moves!

Reminders for this week:
