Uses shapes appropriately for tasks

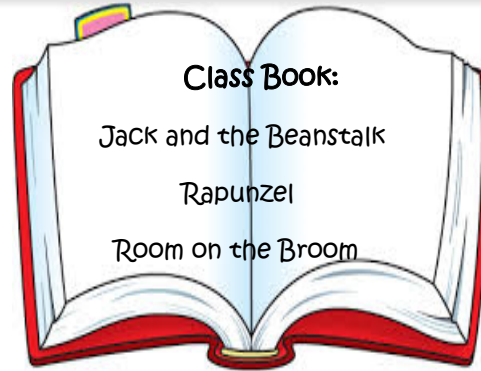
Understanding the World:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Welcomes praise for what they have done.
Enjoys responsibility for carrying out tasks.
Confident to talk to other children and communicates freely about home.

Physical Development:

Moves freely with confidence such as slithering, rolling, jumping etc.
Draws lines and circles with gross motor movements.
Uses scissors to cut paper.
Manages to wash and dry hands.

Communication & Language:

Shows an understanding of prepositions such as under, on top, behind.
Questions why things happen, asks why, how, when.
Uses talk in pretending that objects stand for something else.
Sometimes gives meaning to marks as they draw and paint.

Expressive Art and Design:

Explores colours and how they can be changed.
Constructs and builds with a purpose.
