Explore how materials can be mixed together – 'magic potions and more!'

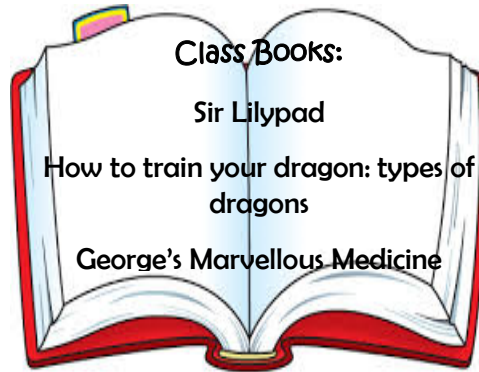
