Further develop questioning skills.

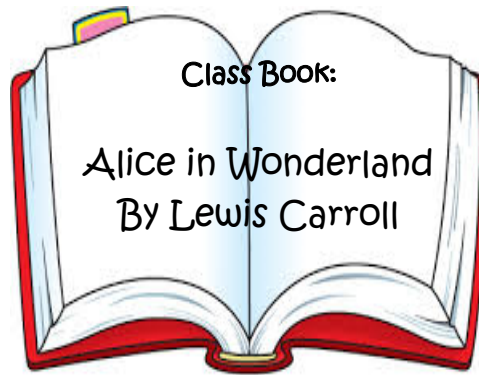
Science:
