Dear Parent/ Carer,

Thank you so much for coming to our Welcome Meeting. I was very sorry not to be able to attend, however, we will offer catch- up sessions in September and I will be there! We listened carefully to your questions and met swiftly to finalise the plans for September which we can happily share with you now.

### 30 HOUR PLACES AVAILABLE!

From September 2017, New Earswick Primary School will be able to offer you 30 hour places for those eligible. We will also be able to offer the option to top up 15 hour places. We will be based in the Nursery room attached to Little Rowans Pre-School. From January, we are planning to work in close partnership with Little Rowans Pre-School to offer a joint 30 hour provision.

You said	We did
I am worried about my child when he/she goes to the toilet.	We will open the Early Years Class in the old Nursery Classroom where toilets are in the same space. Your child will no longer need to use the toilets in the corridor of the main school. We will let the Reception Children use the outdoor space in the Reception Room and we will allow teachers to take small groups to other rooms when appropriate to support their learning.
Is breakfast club and wrap around care available from 7:30?	From September, our wrap around care will be available from 7:30 am and you will be able to book place from today by telephoning the school office on 555970.
Are we offering 30hr Nursery places? Do we have to use 30 Hours?	Yes. From September, we will offer 30 hours of Nursery provision. During your home visit, our staff will let you know how to sign up. No you do not have to use all of your 30 hour provision.
My child is young for the year group, should I wait until January?	You have the right to choose when your child starts school and we will support you with this. As a school, we feel that children who start together in September really bond and get off to a flying start. Our Nursery Room will be set up like many child care and Private Nursery provisions to support a 'play based' day. If you choose to start after January, Little Rowans will continue your provision and work with us to make the transfer as smooth as possible.
Can I volunteer my time?	Yes please! We are always looking for regular volunteers. Please email or telephone school and we will meet with you to discuss the options.
